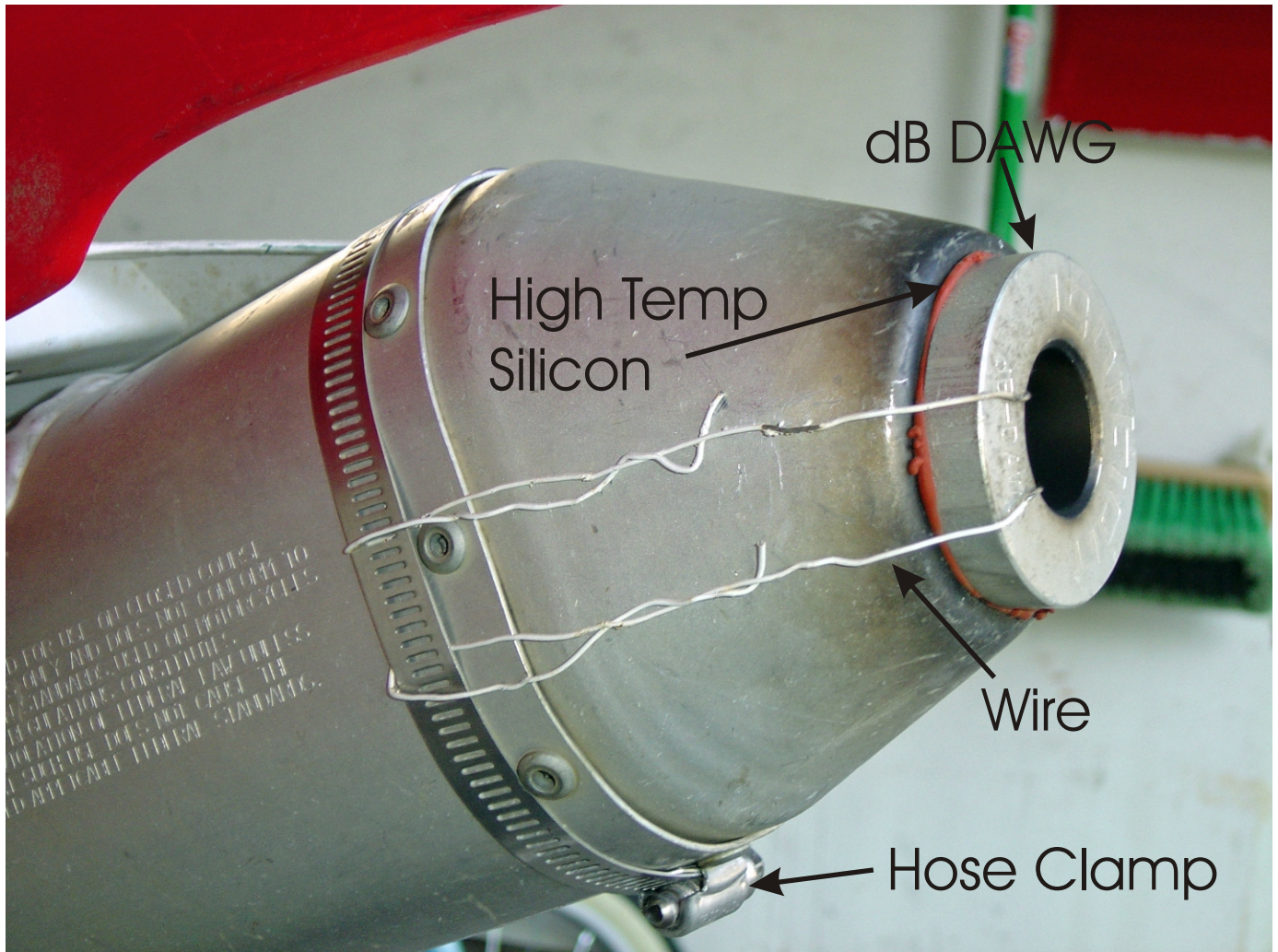


# Keep your DAWG on a leash!



dB DAWGs are great for reducing the noise from your bike, but you need to send them to obedience school! They tend to go astray (fall out) quite frequently and they tend to poop on your pipe (carbon blow-by). You can solve these problems by threading a bit of wire through the dB DAWG and then wrapping it around a 4" (100 mm) hose clamp installed behind the rivets. This will keep your DAWG close to home.

A bit of high temperature silicon seal, like you use when repacking a silencer, will keep the exhaust from leaving carbon deposits between the DAWG and the pipe.
